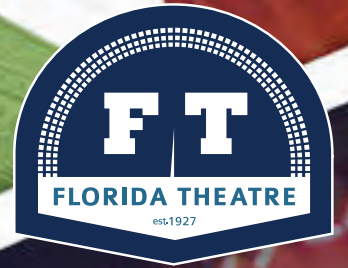

About the Florida Theatre

The Florida Theatre Performing Arts Center, Inc. is the nonprofit corporation that has managed, programmed and preserved the historic Florida Theatre in downtown Jacksonville, Florida since 1987, in a public/private partnership with the City of Jacksonville, which owns the building. The 1,865-seat historic theatre first opened in 1927 and is listed on the National Register of Historic Places. The venue promotes its own events, hosting over 200 individual performances this year. Annual attendance is consistently ranked by the concert industry magazine Pollstar as one of the Top 5 theatres in the nation under 2,000 seats. The Florida Theatre has been seen and heard nationally on Showtime (Larry Wilmore, 2012); Sirius Satellite Radio (Gregg Allman, New Year's Eve 2013); AXS TV Network (Lynyrd Skynyrd, 2015); National Public Radio (Michael Feldman's Whad'ya Know?, 2016); Netflix (Katt Williams, 2017); and on a worldwide Valentine's Day live stream by Air Supply (2021).

The Florida Theatre Performing Arts Center, Inc. is the nonprofit corporation that manages and programs the historic Florida Theatre on behalf of the City of Jacksonville, which owns the building, and we are pleased to present you with the Annual Report for the fiscal year that ended on September 30, 2025.

As a nonprofit corporation serving the community, we believe that it is important for us to transparently report on the operations of the organization from time to time. In addition to being a financially profitable year, we would like to highlight these significant achievements of fiscal 2025:

- **The Florida Theatre presented 213 events and performances throughout the year.**
- **In 2025, more than 202,000 guests visited the Florida Theatre.**
- **Over 1,688 households and 29 corporate partners provided financial support for the Florida Theatre's nonprofit arts and cultural activities, indicating a broad base of support for the institution and its programs.**

The icing on the cake this year was that on July 20 at the League of Historic American Theatres conference Pittsburgh, the Florida Theatre received the Outstanding Historic Theatre Award for 2025. The Outstanding Historic Theatre Award, "recognizes a theatre that demonstrates excellence through its community impact, quality of programs and services, and quality of the restoration or rehabilitation of its historic structure. An award-winning theatre will have demonstrated excellence through significant achievement, the impact of its services and breadth of populations served, and the length of time and/or intensity of its activities."

We are honored to be recognized by the League for our work but are just as honored by the support you have provided for the Florida Theatre as ticket holders, donors and supporters. We are pleased to provide this report to you.

CENTENNIAL CAMPAIGN SUPPORTERS (ALL YEARS)

The Centennial Campaign was founded in 2018 to improve the historic Florida Theatre and its physical assets in time for the Florida Theatre's 100th anniversary in 2027. To date, the campaign has funded \$19.5 million of improvements to the Florida Theatre that increase the organization's ability to generate revenue; improve the customer experience; and reduce daily operating expenses through capital improvements. The campaign has already funded new and historically appropriate theatre seats; improved wheelchair access; a new concert sound system; a new assistive listening system; a new theatrical lighting system; construction of the PNC Bank Lounge; a new heating, air conditioning and ventilation plant; relocation of the electrical vault from the first to third floor, where it is not a flood risk; modernization of all the public restrooms; painting of the interior with fidelity to the original 1927 palette of colors; demolition of an abandoned chimney, freeing 35 square feet of stage space;

repurposing of an abandoned mechanical room into the very first dressing room on stage left; and repurposing of the abandoned boiler room into the very first backstage Green Room.

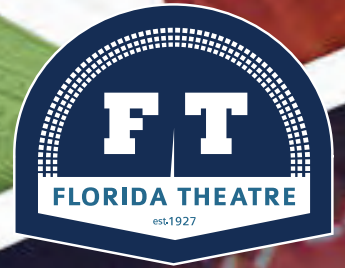
